## 3. Approval of Forestry Management Services contract

Resolution Number 2018-03-05-01, Authorizing a Contractor for Tree Cutting on 5 Scobie Drive Parcel.

An RFP was released in early February for Forestry Management Services for a portion of 5 Scobie Drive property. The RFP included clearing nine acres of trees and shrubs; removal of large trees; chipping of shrubs and small trees, with chips remaining on site in a designated area; and maintaining a buffer zone as detailed on a map. Two bids were received, and the IDA chose the lower bid, received from A.W. Coon.

## 4. Approval of CT Male Contract – To Provide Services During Tree Clearing

Jim McIver, from C.T. Male, submitted a proposal for services/tasks to be undertaken while the tree clearing process occurs—marking of boundary for tree cutting, interim inspection(s), and final inspection.
